

## Reduction in First Time Entrants into Criminal Justice System

December 2009

- 50% reduction in First Time Entrants (FTE) in the Youth Justice system in Bradford since 2005/6.
- This national target measures the number of young offenders who have received a Fixed Penalty Notice, Police Reprimand, Final Warning or appeared in Court for the first time.
- Bradford's performance is significantly better than the Regional average of 12% and National average of 6%.
- This results in fewer victims of crime and less young people with criminal records that may hamper their chance of getting future employment.
