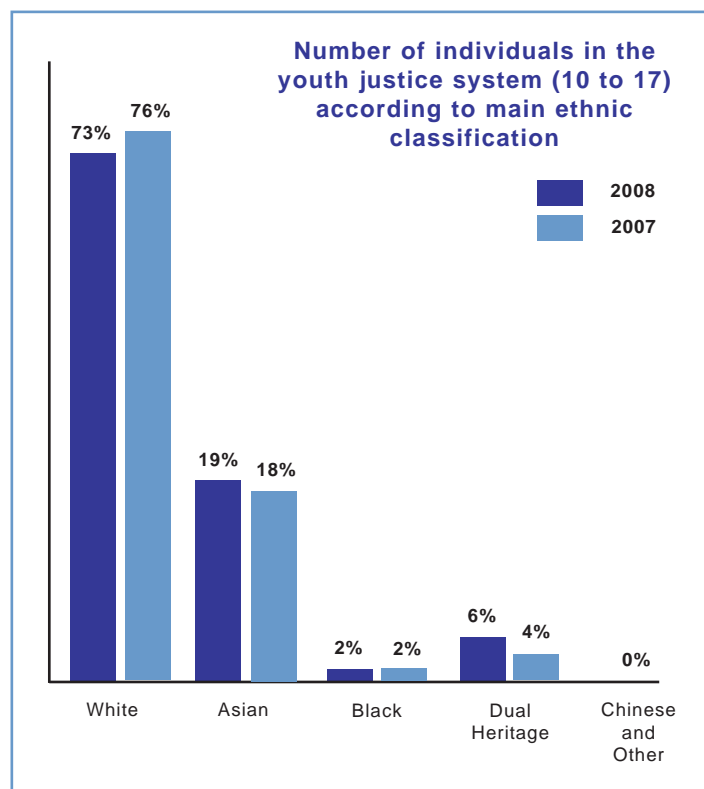
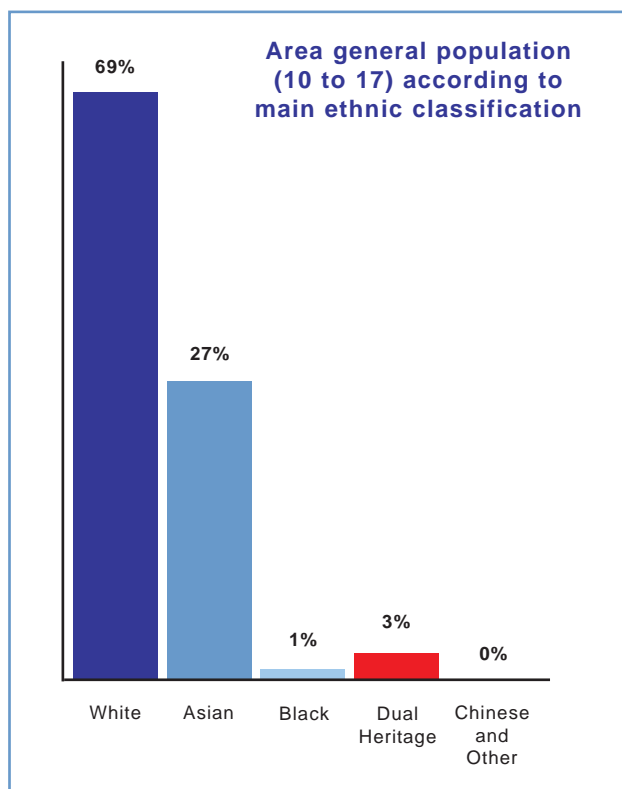


Bradford YOT Race Audit 2008

Summary & Key Findings

"All Youth Offending Teams (YOTs) should have an action plan in place to ensure that any difference between the ethnic composition of offenders in all pre-court and post-court disposals and the ethnic composition of the local community is reduced year on year."



- **White young offenders (73%) over represented in criminal justice system compared to 10-17 population (69%) and has decreased by 3% since 2007**
- **Lower number of asian young offenders (19%) compared to 10-17 population (27%), a 1% increase since 2007**
- **Slightly higher proportion of black offenders (2%) compared to 10-17 population (1%) but no change since 2007**
- **Significant reduction in black young people entering the system for the first time - 60 in 2005, 11 in 2008**
- **Increase in dual heritage offenders (6%) compared to the 10-17 population (3%), a 2% increase since 2007**
- **Higher breach rates for white and dual heritage young offenders for not complying with the court order**
