Static Factors

Offence Type

Scoring

Motoring = 4

Burglary = 3

Other = 0

Age at first

10-12 = 4

Reprimand/Caution/Warning

13-17 = 3

No previous Reprimand/Caution/Warning = 0

Age at first conviction

10-13 = 4

14-17 = 3

No previous convictions = 0

Number of previous convictions

4 or more = 4

1 to 3 = 3

No previous convictions = 0

Total Static Factors = 0-16

plus Total Dynamic Factors (12 Asset Sections scored 0-4) = 0-48

Total Static and Dynamic Factors = 0-64

Determining Intervention Level

Child/Young Person Profile		Intervention Level
Low likelihood of reoffending or low risk of serious harm	0 to 14	Standard
Medium likelihood of reoffending or medium risk of serious harm	15 to 32	Enhanced
High likelihood of reoffending or high risk/very high risk of serious harm	33 to 64	Intensive

Statutory Contacts for Assessed Intervention Level

Intervention Level	Contacts per month for first 3 months	Contacts per month for rest of order
Standard (0-14)	2	1
Enhanced (15-32)	4	2
Intensive (33-64)	12	4
