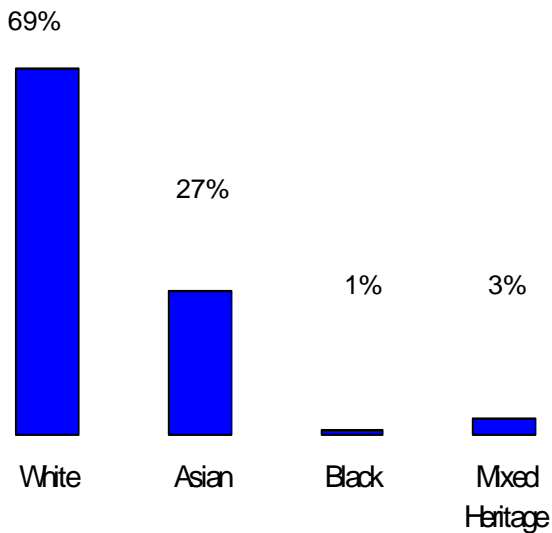


Bradford YOT Race Audit 2010

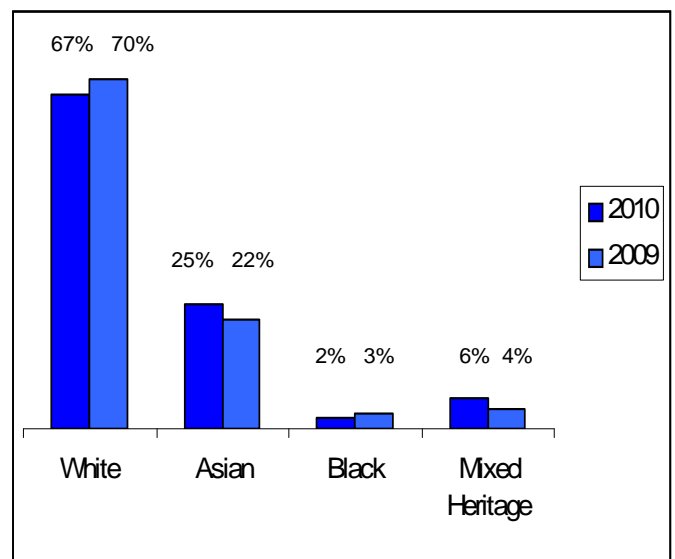
Summary and Key Findings

“All Youth Offending Teams (YOTs) should have an action plan in place to ensure that any difference between the ethnic composition of offenders in all pre-court and post-court disposals and the ethnic composition of the local community is reduced year on year.”

- White young offenders (67%) slightly under represented in criminal justice system compared to 10-17 population (69%) and has decreased by 3% since 2009.
- Lower number of Asian young offenders (25%) compared to 10-17 population (27%), but a 3% increase since 2009.
- Slightly higher proportion of black offenders (2%) compared to 10-17 population (1%) but a decrease of 1% on 2009
- Slight increase in mixed heritage offenders (6%) compared to the 10-17 population (3%).
