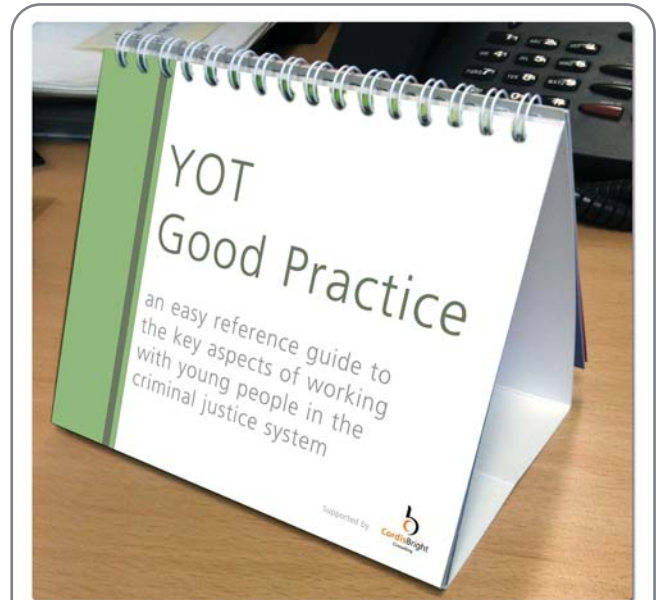

Intervention Plan

A good intervention plan must:

- **Be prioritised** - the top 3 scores in Asset should be the top 3 priorities in your plan
- Be completed within **15 working days** of sentence
- Prioritise according to Risk of Harm
- Focus on achievable change
- Set relevant goals and realistic timescales
- Reflect national standards
- Integrate Risk Management Plan and Vulnerability Management Plan
- Take into account Safeguarding needs
- Incorporate young person's learning needs/style
- Take account of victim issues and victim safety
- Be agreed by the young person/parent or guardian

Review of Asset

Asset to be reviewed every 3 months or when there is significant change in the young person's life which requires further assessment of their risk. This could include:

- Homelessness
- Further offending
- Exclusion from school
- Domestic violence
- Increased substance misuse
- Episodes of self-harm
- Bereavement
- Risk to victim

- Ensure it is refreshed with current and relevant information only
- Clearly state in summary what work has been undertaken
- Record the impact of your work and evidence any change of scores
- Ensure vulnerability and risk sections inc. ROSH, RMP, VMP are reviewed
